



## **Covid-19 Vaccination Exemption Form for Yankee Dental Congress 2022 (“YDC 2022”)**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, understand that effective January 15, 2022 the City of Boston requires individuals ages 12 and older to provide proof of receiving at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine prior to entering certain establishments including the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center, event venues such as the Seaport Hotel function rooms where the House of Delegates will take place, restaurants, bars, etc., unless they have a medical condition, disability, or other civil rights-related reason that justifies an exemption.

- I certify that I have a medical contraindication to the COVID-19 vaccine or a disability that I believe necessitates an exemption from this vaccination requirement. This certification means that the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine to me would likely be detrimental to my health.
- I certify that I hold a sincere religious belief that necessitates an exemption from this vaccination requirement. This certification means that the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine to me would require me to compromise my sincerely-held religious belief.

I understand and acknowledge that, as a result of my exemption request, my admission to YDC 2022 may be conditioned on my adherence to certain additional safety-related requirements, such as enhanced face covering and/or social distancing protocols.

I certify that the information being provided is complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge, and I understand that any intentional misrepresentation contained in this request may result in removal from any Yankee or MDS affiliated events, programs, courses, etc.
